

The Great Leucan Faceoff Contest

2025–2026 Edition

Official Rules

This contest is open to hockey teams participating in The Great Leucan Faceoff by organizing an activity or fundraising event in support of Leucan between November 8, 2025, and March 15, 2026. A Grand Prize will be awarded to the team that raises the highest amount, and a Participation Prize will be drawn among all teams that raise at least \$500.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the Participation Prize, teams must raise a minimum of \$500 in donations for Leucan through the official My Leucan Day fundraising platform, or via cheque made out to *Leucan*, bank transfer, or cash (upon request, details on payment methods will be provided by a Leucan representative). Donations made outside the My Leucan Day platform must clearly indicate the team's name to be attributed correctly. All eligible teams will automatically be entered into the contest. The Grand Prize will be awarded to the team that raises the most funds. To be considered for the prizes, donations must be received and processed by Leucan no later than Sunday, March 15, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. Employees of Leucan, members of Leucan's Board of Directors, and anyone residing in the same household as such individuals are eligible to participate.

Draw Conditions

The identification of the Grand Prize winner and the draw for the Participation Prize will take place on Tuesday, March 17, 2026. The Grand Prize will be awarded to the team that raises the most funds. The Participation Prize will be drawn among all teams that have raised at least \$500, with one team selected at random from all eligible entries. The random draw will be conducted using an online draw tool, and a screenshot of the winning team's name will be saved as proof. The decision of the organizing committee is final.

Prize Description

The Grand Prize consists of a private hockey clinic at the Bell Centre led by former Montreal Canadiens player Paul Byron, including an exclusive guided tour of the Bell Centre and official Canadiens merchandise. The clinic will take place in April 2026. The exact date and details will be determined by the Montreal Canadiens in coordination with the winning team, based on availability. All travel or accommodation expenses incurred to attend the clinic are the responsibility of the winning team. The Participation Prize, consisting of official Montreal Canadiens merchandise, will also be drawn among teams that raise at least \$500.

Prize Distribution

Leucan will contact the winning teams by email or phone within three (3) days following March 17, 2026. Winning teams must respond within three (3) days of receiving the email or call to confirm acceptance of the prize. If the Grand Prize-winning team does not respond within the required timeframe, the prize will be offered to the team with the next-highest fundraising total, following the same communication process, until a team confirms acceptance. If the Participation Prize-winning team does not respond within the required timeframe, a second draw will be conducted under the same terms until a team confirms acceptance of the prize.

Release and Publicity

By accepting a prize, winning teams consent, without compensation, to the use of their name, logo, city of residence, and/or statements about winning for promotional purposes by Leucan. This contest is organized by Leucan, in collaboration with the Montreal Canadiens.
